Afrovenator is the most complete predatory dinosaur from the Cretaceous period ever discovered in Africa. Its skull has rows of long, blade-shaped teeth for slicing into prey, and its bones reveal that it was a cousin to *Allosaurus*, a 150-million-year-old dinosaur that lived in North America. However, *Afrovenator* has longer, more slender bones and was likely more lightweight and fleet-footed than *Allosaurus*.
